SicherheitsExpo Alpe Adria: Klagenfurt's first Security Expo, featuring a top-class programme of talks

On 14 and 15 October, the SicherheitsExpo Alpe Adria will be the new meeting place for experts, decision-makers and trade visitors from the security sector. Exhibitors from the fields of access control, fire protection, IT security, perimeter protection and video surveillance will be presenting their latest innovations, solutions and products. The event will be complemented by a high-calibre programme of talks, in which renowned speakers will present the latest developments and forward-looking ideas in security technology, whilst offering practical insights into current challenges and potential solutions. Klagenfurt –On 14 and 15 October, the SicherheitsExpo Alpe Adria will make its debut, bringing the concept of the SicherheitsExpo – the leading trade fair for security technology in southern Germany, which has been successfully held in Munich for 20 years – to Klagenfurt. The technical partners for the new SicherheitsExpo are the VSÖ – the Association of Austrian Security Companies – and the KFV – the Austrian Road Safety Board. The VSÖ is helping to shape the content of the expert forum at the trade fair and ensures that Austrian industry requirements are taken into account as effectively as possible. The KFV is also contributing further topical issues and technical insights to the programme.

Specialist presentations on current security issues

On both days of the exhibition, SicherheitsExpo Alpe Adria will be hosting specialist presentations on current topics and developments in the industry. Renowned speakers and leading experts will demonstrate and discuss cutting-edge security technologies. Admission to the presentation programme is included in the exhibition ticket. The exhibition opens on 14

October by Provincial Councillor Dr Beate Prettner. To kick off the programme of talks, General Mag. Andreas Holzer MA, Director of the Federal Criminal Police Office, will deliver a keynote address on the topic “The New Vulnerability – Security in an Age of Permanent Crises”. This will be followed by a panel discussion on the topic “The polycrisis as a permanent state – Are our systems still manageable?”. Participants include Dr Armin Kaltenegger, Head of the Legal Department at KfV; Dipl. Ing. Georg Schwondra, Partner at Cyber Risk; Mag. Alexander Kraus, Head of Cluster Central Europe; and Dipl. Ing. Bernhard Steindl, member of the Executive Board at ÖWD.

Other high-profile speakers and experts, such as Patricia Rosenauer and Stefan Georgiev from KfV, Kristian Kastner from HIKVISION Germany, Sven Horstmann from Klüh Security and Marvin Keßler from Geutebrück, will be taking part in the programme at the SicherheitsExpo Alpe Adria. Topics include, for example, “AI in security technology”, legal regulations concerning the protection of critical infrastructure, the early detection of forest fires using drones, and the motives and methods behind burglary offences.
