SicherheitsExpo Berlin – Industry platform with top-class lecture programme

On 17 and 18 September, SicherheitsExpo will take place for the first time in Berlin. The range of around 70 exhibitors covers all areas of security technology, such as access control, video surveillance, fire protection, perimeter protection and IT security. A specialist forum complements the trade fair programme. The 1st Berlin Fire Protection Conference and a KRITIS workshop, organised by the Federal Association for the Protection of Critical Infrastructures BSKI, will take place parallel to SicherheitsExpo. The venue is STATION Berlin.

Berlin – There is great interest in the new industry event: the first edition of SicherheitsExpo Berlin is experiencing high demand from both exhibitors and visitors. SicherheitsExpo Berlin is aimed at those responsible for corporate security, plant security, fire protection and insurance, as well as authorities, the police and fire brigade, architects, security consultants, specialised security companies and IT managers. The aim of the trade fair is to demonstrate technologies that protect companies, private individuals and the public sector against criminal attacks from inside and outside: Industrial plants, banks, clinics, transport companies, retail, railway stations, airports, museums, private individuals and public authorities. The trade fair programme will be supplemented by various information and training opportunities.

Specialist presentations and networking

In addition to the exhibition area in Hall 7 of STATION Berlin, the lecture forum offers an additional opportunity to exchange information. It will focus on the latest information on the latest developments in security technology. The patron of the event, Berlin's police commissioner Dr Barbara Slowik Meisel, will give the opening lecture on the first day of the event. On both days of the trade fair, various specialised topics will be highlighted in the forum, such as cyber security, security measures at German missions abroad, video surveillance and smart technologies.

1st Berlin Fire Protection Conference

Under the direction of internationally renowned fire protection expert Dr Wolfgang J. Friedl, the first Berlin Fire Protection Conference will take place as part of SicherheitsExpo Berlin. The two-day specialist programme will focus on important fire protection topics and offer participating fire protection managers from companies and other institutions practical, first-hand expert knowledge. Participation in the fire protection conference is eligible for continuing education recognition. Participants of the 1st Berlin Fire Protection Conference can also visit the SicherheitsExpo Berlin with their ticket.

KRITIS workshop organised by the BKSI

The Federal Association for the Protection of Critical Infrastructures BSKI is organising a KRITIS workshop as part of the SicherheitsExpo Berlin. On 17 and 18 September, current challenges relating to the protection of critical infrastructures will be highlighted. Dr Hans-Walter Borries, Deputy Chairman of the BSKI, will moderate the event. Topics on the programme include police security, homeland security, KRITIS in rail transport, airport security and new protection concepts, sabotage protection for companies and administration, civil protection and strategies for strengthening cyber defence in a more complex threat landscape. A panel discussion on the second day will give participants the opportunity to discuss current challenges and benefit from the industry network. Participants in the KRITIS workshop can also use their ticket to visit SicherheitsExpo Berlin.

The 1st Berlin Fire Protection Conference and the KRITIS Workshop can also be attended on one day only.

SicherheitsExpo has been successfully held in Munich for over 20 years. The new event in Berlin offers visitors from the greater Berlin area as well as from the east and north-east of Germany and neighbouring countries a new event on the important topic of security technology. The organiser is the private trade fair organiser AFAG Messen und Ausstellungen.
