Outlook for the SicherheitsExpo trade fair year: Munich kicks things off

This year, various security trade fairs organised by AFAG are on the annual calendar, focusing on current developments, important topics and forward-looking solutions at different locations: SicherheitsExpo Munich has been held annually at the MOC Munich for over 20 years. This year, the event will open its doors on 1 and 2 July. Shortly afterwards, on 15 and 16 July, KRIFA Münster, a specialist congress on security and crisis prevention with an accompanying exhibition, will kick off. On 14 and 15 October, SicherheitsExpo Alpe Adria will take place for the first time at the Klagenfurt Exhibition Centre (Austria).

Munich/Münster/Klagenfurt/Berlin – Especially in times of increased security requirements in business and society, SecurityExpo is the trade fair platform for presenting and demonstrating security technology that can protect companies and the public sector from criminal attacks from within and without. One of the main themes of the trade fair is the protection of critical infrastructures. Topics include access control, video surveillance, fire protection, perimeter protection and IT security.

SicherheitsExpo Munich – 1 and 2 July 2026

On 1 and 2 July, SicherheitsExpo Munich offers trade visitors the opportunity to obtain comprehensive information on current security issues in person. Industry experts will be on hand to demonstrate how companies and public institutions can effectively secure their sensitive areas, minimise risks and comply with legal requirements. The focus will be on innovative technologies, digital security solutions and practical strategies. The preliminary list of exhibitors at SicherheitsExpo Munich is already online, with over 100 exhibitors expected at the MOC Munich in July. Tickets are already available online.

Specialist presentations on current security topics

On both days of the trade fair, SicherheitsExpo Munich will offer specialist presentations on current topics and developments in the industry. Attendance at the lectures is included in the exhibition ticket for all visitors. The opening lecture on security in business and society will be given by Bavaria's Minister of the Interior, Joachim Herrmann. The focus will then shift to topics such as new solutions for access control, holistically networked security solutions, the use of drones and robotics, IT security and safety in the workplace, and the protection of critical infrastructure..

NEW: KRIFA Münster – 15th and 16th of July 2026

On 15 and 16 July, the trade congress and exhibition on security and crisis prevention will take place at the MCC Halle Münsterland. KRIFA Münster took a break for several years. Now, the Federal Association for the Protection of Critical Infrastructures (BSKI) and AFAG Messen und Ausstellungen GmbH are reviving this important event. KRIFA is the event for prevention, crises, civil protection, fire services, police, rescue services, aid organisations, healthcare and the relevant civil emergency response and security authorities in the Münsterland region. The event centres on the conference, which is accompanied by a trade exhibition.

NEW: SicherheitsExpo Alpe Adria – 14th and 15th October 2026

The SicherheitsExpo Alpe Adria will celebrate its premiere on 14 and 15 October at the Klagenfurt Exhibition Centre. For the first time, a platform for innovative solutions and current developments in the security industry is being created in the Alpe-Adria region. This gives the SicherheitsExpo a new location in Austria. The content of the lecture forum will be organised by the exhibition's partner, the VSÖ (Association of Security Companies in Austria), ensuring the highest level of technical expertise, practical relevance and industry relevance. The SicherheitsExpo Alpe Adria is a security exhibition with a clear focus on the specific needs, requirements and market conditions of the Austrian security industry.

Outlook: 2027 SicherheitsExpo Berlin – 22nd and 23rd September 2027

The Security Expo Berlin took place for the first time in 2025 and was a hit with exhibitors and visitors alike. Its central location in the capital made it possible to reach new target groups and include additional topics. Demand for exhibition space is already high.
